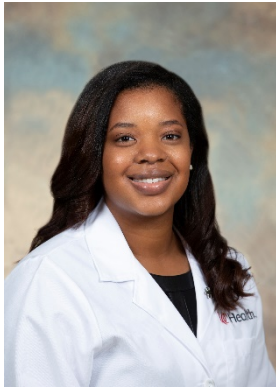
Why did you choose University of Cincinnati?

Interests within obstetrics and gynecology?

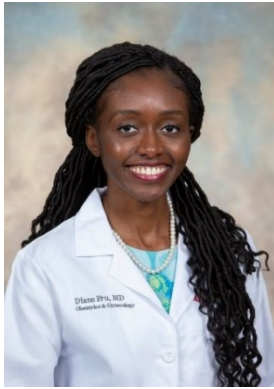
I am interested in quality improvement, community engagement and pursuing a fellowship in Gynecology Oncology.

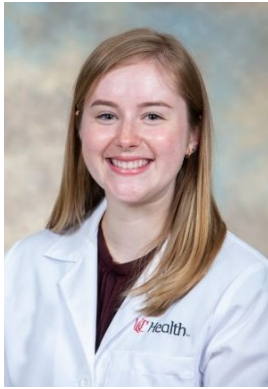

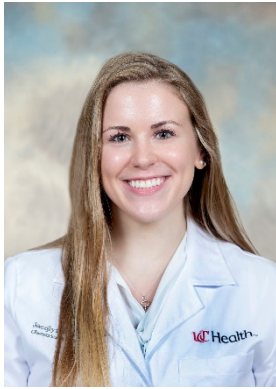
Why did you choose University of Cincinnati?
